ABOUT THE HOST INSTITUTE

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS AND PAPERS

The members/non-members of the Punjab Academy of Sciences are requested to submit their original contributions for any of the referred sections (A-E). Not more than two papers either alone or with co-authors could be submitted. Abstract (maximum 250 words, see the Abstract template on the Institute/Congress website), formatted on MS word (A4 size) in New Times Roman, Title 12 point and authors information and text size 10 point, in single line spacing with 2.54 cm right and 2.54 cm left, top and bottom margins 2.54 cm, should compulsorily be sent through electronic mail to punjabsciencecongress2020@gmail.com as an attachment on or before January 07, 2020 for any of the sections as per the suitability of the subject matter. The name of the presenting author should be marked with an asterisk (*) along with email ID. The decision for oral/poster presentation will be strictly followed as per approval of the technical review committee. Papers screened by the committee may either be published in the seminar proceedings or selected papers may be published in the special issue of Journal of Punjab Academy of Sciences as per norms.

YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD

A special session for the presentation of papers for the young scientist award will be held on February 8, 2020. Young scientists upto an age of 35 years on December 31, 2019 may send their abstract and full length papers to the Organizing Secretary, 23rd Punjab Science Congress, separately on or before January 07, 2020.

Young scientists (proof of age to be furnished) selected for best presentation in each section (A-E) will be awarded a certificate of honor, medal and cash prize. Each of them will be given 12 minutes for the presentation and 3 minutes for discussion. The name of the section pertaining to the paper should be clearly mentioned on the envelope. The papers will be screened as per the norms of the Academy.

PRESENTATIONS (ORAL/POSTER)

There will be parallel technical sessions for invited speakers followed by the oral presentation of papers for each sections (A-E), separately. Thirty minutes and seven minutes, shall be given for invited talk and oral presentation, respectively along with three minutes for discussion.

- Multimedia facilities for power point presentation will be available.
- Each participant for poster presentation will be provided with a space measuring 100cm X 70cm, for mounting the display of written material, diagrams, photographs etc.

WEATHER


