

## **Guidelines for Oral Presentations**

Oral presentations will be allotted 08 minutes each, including the discussions. Please prepare visual aids to accompany your presentation. Include only as many slides as you can discuss meaningfully in your allotted time. Limit each slide to a single idea. Make them simple and readable from at least 50 ft. (18-24 pt font). Graphs are usually better than tables, in case the tables are required include only critical information.

## **Guidelines for Poster Presentations**

All Poster presenters are requested to be present at their postersite during the entire session. All delegates are invited to walk around the poster area to view the posters and to enter into lively and challenging discussions with the poster presenters. Assistance and material for mounting the posters will be available at the poster help desk in the hall. Setting-up a poster generally takes at least 10 minutes.

- Poster board size: Size of the usable area- 80 cm x 140 cm.
- Use a clear typeface and, if possible, a laser printer.
- The poster should be readable from a distance of 2-3 meters (font size 20-24 pt.)
- Graphs and figures should be readable from a distance of 2-3 meters. They should be drawn with a minimum line width of 1 mm.
