POST LOCKDOWN ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Online Registration: The Institute successfully managed to provide remote access for payment of semester fee and registration through ERP. In view of economic slowdown due to pandemic, the Institute facilitated the students by extending fee window and date of registration.

Online Teaching: In view of the continued lockdown due to covid-19 pandemic, the odd semester of the academic year 2020-21 was conducted online. Based on multiple rounds of discussions with CRs, the Institute selected the suitable online delivery platform and engaged G-suite for the purpose. Training sessions for the faculty were conducted to familiarize them about the online teaching. Keeping in view the constraints and remote locations of most of the students, the teaching and evaluation of this semester was done in two phases. Fifty percent load was offered in phase I, which started on 10.08.2020 and concluded on 04.10.2020. The rest of the teaching was

offered in Phase II from 19.10.2020 to 31.12.2020. Summer term were also conducted in online mode for ICD and UG passing out batches.

'No Dues' and other certificates through ERP: Physical movement to various sections to get the "No Dues" certificate was a big issue. Under prevailing situation, the Institute made it possible to offer "No Dues" feature online through ERP. Facility is also created to get various certificates (Bonafide, Migration, Character certificate, duplicate DMC etc.) through ERP in online mode.

Standing committee of Senate: In view of changing scenario, there was a need to take policy decisions on academic matters. The Senate in its 29th meeting constituted standing committee of Senate. Six meetings took place to address matters related to academics and student's concerns. (The efforts of Academic team, Accounts Section and ERP Team are appreciable).
