INSTITUTE ACTIVITIES

NATIONAL BOARD OF ACCREDITATION (NBA) APPROVED THE ACCREDITATION STATUS OF ALL THE UG (BE) PROGRAMS OF SLIET

It is matter of great pleasure and celebration that National Board of Accreditation (NBA) approved the Accreditation status of all the UG (BE) Programs of SLIET, for a period of 3 years. It was all due to hard work and perseverance of our worthy Director Prof. Shailendra Jain, Dean(A) Prof. Ajat Shatru Arora and all members of Team SLIET.

Accreditation is a process of quality assurance and improvement, whereby a programme continues to meet the prescribed Norms and Standards. It is a kind of recognition which indicates that a programme or Institution fulfils certain standards. To ensure the same, the Institute has undergone for the NBA Accreditation process of 4 Year Bachelor of Engineering (BE) Programs started since 2014. It was the 4th cycle of NBA Accreditation (3rd for FET, CSE, ECE and EIE, and 1st for EE).

The Self-Assessment Reports (SARs) were submitted to the NBA in the month of Dec 2019 soon after fulfilment of eligibility of two pass out batches.

A team of National Board of Accreditation (NBA), consisting of 11 members visited SLIET Longowal,


from 9-11 April 2021, for the accreditation of all 7 BE Programs. The team included three local external experts (visiting experts), who visited the Institute physically, seven external subject experts (one for each UG program) and Chairman of the committee were available through online mode. During the initial two days, the experts critically analysed the academic, administrative records and physical facilities available at the institute and the departmental level through online mode, with the help of local external experts. The institute made special arrangements for online interactions with faculty, staff, students and their parents, alumni and employers as part of this visit. During the Exit Meeting, held on 11.04.2021, the Institute opted to continue with the NBA approval for all the seven UG programs.

This is an attempt by the institute to impart Outcome Based Education (OBE) and target to achieve desirable outcomes (in terms of knowledge, skills, attitudes and behaviour) at the end of a program.

Prof. Shailendra Jain, Director SLIET congratulated all for this achievement.


Interactive Talk on Resilience

Grant of Patent to Director SLIET

A Patent (Application No.: 1829/MUM/2013) has been granted to Prof. Shailendra Jain, Director SLIET as an inventor entitled "Cascaded Multilevel Inverter" on 29th April, 2021 bearing patent no. 365637. This invention relates to a cascaded multilevel inverter using series connection of cross connected sources based sub-multilevel inverters. An alternative generalisation of CCS-MLI is presented in which 'cells' with two input sources are series connected so as to form a cascaded structure. The primary objective is to retain the salient features of the CCS-MLI structure with two input sources; viz. fundamental switching operation of higher voltage rated switches and possibility of equal load sharing amongst the equal input DC sources.
