

2-DAYS PROGRESS REVIEW WORKSHOP ON VISION PLAN "SLIET-2030"

In view of ongoing technological advancement, needs of the modern society and launch of National Education Policy NEP-2020, it has become necessary for higher educational institute (HEI) to review its future plans and role. Keeping same in mind, SLIET is also working for its Vision Plan "SLIET-2030" as per priority to establish high quality Institution in disadvantaged geographic area in NEP-2020. A 2- Days Progress Review Workshop on Vision Plan "SLIET-2030" was organised on 30th

September and 1st October 2021, coordinated by Prof Harish Chopra, Registrar (Officiating), under the Chairmanship of Prof Shailendra Jain, Director SLIET. The workshop was presided by Prof. J. S. Dhillon, Dean (A).

The institute vision plan was deliberated in two parts: Short Term and Long Term Activities. Brainstorming sessions were conducted in 4 sessions on following activities:

Short Term Activities

- Holistic development of the students through Personality/Communication Skill/ Aptitude/Logical Reasoning, Universal Human Values and other curricular and cocurricular activities through student clubs
- Restructuring of ICD, setting of industry sponsored labs, Virtual labs etc
- Establishment of centre of excellence (COE) in advance areas of research and innovation

Long Term Activities

- Grant of University Status (Multi disciplinary)
- Development of new skill based programs
- Start of new programs
- Infrastructure development for campus digitization
- Campus development/master Plan of the institute, etc.



All Deans, HoDs, Associated Deans, Faculty In-charges, Faculty/Staff actively participated and presented their vision for the institute. The vote of thanks was proposed by Prof. A. S. Arora, Dean (FSW).

All the teams will submit their reports for placing the same to the Planning & Monitoring Board of the institute. Director, SLIET appreciated the efforts made in this direction with a belief that institute will be considered for grant of the Institute of National Importance/University Status, as per NEP-2020.

Most of the educational Institutes around the world were temporarily closed in March 2020 in an attempt to contain the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic. Many of them had launched distance learning programs and began to plan for recovery from this unexpected menace. 


