India has taken over the Presidency of the G20 for one year from 01 December 2022 to 30 November 2023. The G20, or Group of Twenty, is an intergovernmental forum of the world's major developed and developing economies. It comprises of 19 countries (Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, China, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Republic of Korea, Mexico, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, Turkey, UK, USA) and the European Union (EU).

During India's presidency of G20, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) is running a campaign titled 'Stay Safe Online' aimed at creating awareness among citizens including specially abled persons to stay safe in an online world on the widespread use of social media platforms and rapid adoption of digital payments.
