Experience and No objection certificate (NOC): Two years of post-qualification experience (experience may include stints at multiple organizations) for candidates holding Bachelor / Master Degree in relevant disciplines Candidate needs to provide "No Objection" Certificate issued by his / her organization for pursuing PhD under the executive/ part-time "Ph.D. program for Working Professionals". 1.4(b) Selection / Admission Procedure: Admission to the Ph.D. Program will be based on the TWO STAGE PROCESS through: Applying against available seats in a subject which shall be filled by Online SLIET EntranceTest (SET-V). Institute will admit applicants by a two stage process i.e. Online Entrance test followed by an interview. A two-stage process is mentioned below or as notified by the Institute from time to time: The qualifying marks for the Entrance Test shall be 50%. The syllabus of the Entrance Online Entrance Test shall consist of 50% of research methodology and 50% shall be subject specific. The SET-V would be of 120 minutes/ 2 hours duration. There would be a single question paper of 100 marks having 100 multiple choice questions for assessing the subject proficiency and research aptitude of the candidate. The admission shall be based on the marks obtained above qualifying marks in SET-V and in order of merit. The candidates who have secured 50% marks in the entrance test ae eligible to be called for interview/ viv voce. A relaxation of 5 % marks will be allowed in the entrance examination for the candidates belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC/ differently-abled category, Economically Weaker Section (EWS), and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time. Institute may decide the number of eligible students to be called for an interview based on the number of Ph.D. seats available. Provided that for the selection of candidates based on the entrance test conducted by the Institute, a weightage of 70 % for the entrance test and 30 % for the performance in the interview/viva-voce shall be given. The eligibility or qualifying marks will not be a guarantee for admission. Entrance Tests Syllabus of different subjects is (Information Brochure-SET-2023 available on website: www.sliet.sc.in). The eligible candidates who have qualified UGC/ CSIR (JRF) NET/ NET (ASRB) with fellowship/ State Level eligibility test (SLET/ SET) with fellowship/ GATE are exempted from the entrance examination. However, they should submit the proof of qualifying the examination. But they have to apply online. These candidates are required appear for the interview. Distribution of marks will be as follows: **Through SET Entrance Examination** Total Marks = 100 Marks obtained in Online SET-V weightage 70% of the marks obtained (Maximum 70) Personal Interview/Viva-voce/Presentation- 30 Admission through NET /GATE (Including NET-Assistant Professor
