Institute and Location

Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering & Technology, Longowal (SLIET) is an autonomous body (Deemed-University). It was setup in 1989 by The Ministry of Human Resources Development, GOI with an aim to provide technical education and to cater the technical manpower requirement of the industry.

SLIET is located in a sprawling 451 acres of lush green land in Sangrur (Punjab), about 7 km from the Chandigarh-Bathinda highway in District Sangrur. It is connected by road with Sangrur (18 Km), Patiala (78 Km), Ludhiana (110 Km), Chandigarh (150 Km) and Delhi (360 Km). The nearest railway stations are Sangrur (18Km), Barnala (30 Km) and Dhuri (38 Km). The nearest airport is Chandigarh.
