The Departments of Electronics & Communication Engineering and Computer Science & Engineering, SLIET, jointly organized a two-week AICTE Training and Learning (ATAL) Academy sponsored Advanced Faculty Development Programme on “Artificial Intelligence in 6G Communications” from February 10–22, 2025. The programme, attended by 38 participants, aimed to build expertise in AI-driven 6G technologies and next-generation communication systems.

The inaugural session, presided over by Prof. Ajat Shatru Arora, Director In-Charge, SLIET, emphasized the transformative role of AI in global communication networks. Guest of Honor, Er. V.K. Roy, Deputy Director General (Radiocommunication), TEC, DoT, shared insights from his ITU experience on standard development and patent processes.



Sixteen expert sessions, industrial visits to CSIR-CSIO Chandigarh and C-DAC Mohali, and hands-on training enriched the programme. The valedictory function, graced by Prof. J.S. Dhillon, highlighted AI's central role in 6G evolution. Director Prof. Mani Kant Paswan congratulated the team, reaffirming SLIET's national recognition in education, innovation, and research excellence.

Meeting on AI and Cybercrime Awareness and prevent of drug abuse

Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology (SLIET) convened an important meeting on June 12, 2025, to deliberate on the growing challenges of artificial intelligence misuse and rising cybercrime. The session was chaired by Prof. Mani Kant Paswan, Director, SLIET, and witnessed the participation of senior faculty members alongside distinguished law enforcement officials, including SP Dhruvan Nimbale, DSP Satbir Singh, and cybercrime experts.

The deliberations focused on raising awareness among students and staff regarding responsible use of AI, online safety, and proactive measures to safeguard against cyber fraud. Both academic leaders and police officials emphasized the urgent need for educational institutions to collaborate with law enforcement in building a secure digital ecosystem. The initiative reflects SLIET's commitment to protecting its academic community from emerging cyber threats while fostering a culture of responsible innovation and ethical technology use.

Seminar on Cyber Law, Cyber Crime, and Skill Development at Baba Farid Memorial Education

A seminar on Cyber Law, Cyber Crime, and Skill Development was held on May 3, 2025, at the Baba Farid Memorial Education and Welfare Society Skill Development Center, Longowal, under the framework of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. The session was led by Dr. Pardeep Kumar Jain, who delivered an insightful lecture on the importance of skills in today's digital era, emphasizing how they can be effectively utilized and monetized for sustainable livelihood. Dr. Jain also sensitized participants about the growing threats of cybercrime, highlighting the need for awareness and the role of legal frameworks under cyber law to safeguard individuals and communities. His address combined practical guidance with motivational insights, encouraging participants to remain vigilant and proactive in the digital space. The seminar was attended by more than 60 women, with over 150 women currently receiving training at the center in areas such as tailoring, computer applications, and preparation for competitive examinations. A lively Q&A session allowed participants to share concerns and seek clarity on issues related to skill development and cyber safety. This initiative reflects SLIET's ongoing commitment to women's empowerment and rural development, ensuring that communities are equipped with both practical skills and essential awareness for holistic growth.



Special Seminar on Cyber Law and Cyber Crime, under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

A special seminar on Cyber Law and Cyber Crime was organized on May 5, 2025, at the M&H Block, SLIET Longowal, under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) initiative for students of the Computer Science Department. The session was conducted by Dr. Pardeep Kumar Jain, a noted expert in cybersecurity and legal awareness. Dr. Jain explained that with the growing reliance on digital platforms, cybercrime has emerged as a critical challenge, encompassing activities such as hacking, phishing, identity theft, cyberbullying, online fraud, and data breaches. He emphasized the profound psychological and financial consequences of such crimes, from anxiety and loss of privacy to severe economic setbacks for individuals and small businesses. Highlighting the legal framework under the Information Technology Act, 2000, Dr. Jain elaborated on key provisions including Section 66 (computer-related offences), Section 67 (publishing obscene material online), and Section 72 (breach of confidentiality and privacy). He also guided students on procedures for reporting cybercrimes through police stations and the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal. The seminar concluded with an engaging Q&A session, where students explored real-life cases, career opportunities in cyber law, and the future of cybersecurity in India. The session empowered participants with essential legal awareness and practical strategies for safe digital engagement.



Capacity Building Programme on Positive Mental Health and Well-Being

Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology, Longowal, under the banner of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, organized a Capacity Building Programme on Positive Mental Health, Resilience, and Well-Being on June 3, 2025, at the Computer Auditorium, CSE Block.
