TECHFEST 2025



Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology (SLIET), Longowal, organized its flagship National-level annual technical festival, techFEST'25, on 19–20 September 2025. - Hands-On Focus: Practical training in bilingual typing tools, Unicode Hindi software, and dual-language docs.
- Free & Accessible: No fees; held at IT Lab (Ground Floor), CSE Department.
- Assessment & Certs: Final eval on 13–14 Oct; certificates awarded at Valedictory Function on 14 Oct.



FDP/STTP on Scientific & Technical Writing Tools
