Submission of Abstract & Paper

Papers are invited for the oral and poster presentations. Authors may submit an abstract limited to 250 words containing title, brief introduction, objectives, methodology and major findings of the paper. It should be typed in MS Word, Times New Roman 12-point font, single spacing with one inch margins on all sides. The corresponding author should be marked with asterisk (*) sign. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. The abstract must include the affiliations of all authors along with email address. Papers will be selected for presentation on the basis of review by subject expert. The presenting & registered author will receive participation certificate. Authors are required to submit their original and unpublished research work for presentation (HYBRID MODE) in the conference. Selected papers will be published in book /proceeding form published by some reputed publishers. Only one paper per registered participant will be considered for publication, however, one can be a co-author of more than one paper.
