- As per Clause 19 of Recruitment Notice, the statutory provision for relaxation prescribed by Govt. of India in case of the candidates belonging to reserved categories will be made applicable to them.
- As per Clause 21 of Recruitment Notice, the SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwBD/EWS certificates *should have been issued by the competent authority designated by Central / respective State/ UT Government and should be valid as on the closing date for submission of application.* Divyang / PwBD certificate should mention percentage of disability.

The OBC-NCL and EWS Certificates issued before 01.04.2023 and after 31.08.2023 are INVALID and cannot be considered for providing reservations against this Recruitment Notice issued by SLIET, Longowal. It is further clarified that the documents, which were not submitted with hard-copy of the application and pertaining to period after the last date of submission of the applications i.e., 31.08.2023 will not be considered/taken into account.
8. The representation should be specifically relating to any discrepancy in awarded marks to candidates or Validity of EWS/OBC-NCL Certificates will only be considered. **The representation, on any other matter will not be entertained under any circumstances and shall be filed without entering into any correspondence.**
9. Accordingly, the following amendment/addition is made in the Shortlisting Criteria in Performance Indicate with regard GATE SCORE/GATE PERCENTILE. The marks may be considered as under: -
